Harris County Opens NEW Debris Drop-Off Site for Unincorporated County Residents

Harris County has opened a new debris drop-off site to provide residents of Unincorporated Harris County with additional ways to clear debris quickly from their property.

Residents can now bring their debris to DirtCheapMulch located at 4460 FM 1960 East (West of Artesian Way (Key Map 336Z)). Hours of operation are: Monday-Saturday (8 a.m. – 6 p.m. and Sunday noon- 6 p.m.)

WHAT IS ACCEPTED:

- Vegetative debris (branches, limbs, and shrubbery) **ONLY** will be processed at this site.
- Please **DO NOT** bag your waste. **NO BAGGED WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Tree limbs should be cut into 10' pieces.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED:

- White goods (refrigerators, microwave ovens, air conditioners, ovens, and blenders etc.)
- Construction Debris (singles, siding, treated wood, etc.)
- Household Trash
- Household Hazardous Waste (paint, cleaning products, batteries, etc.)

Household Hazardous Waste should be gathered and disposed of at Household Hazardous Waste events. Call 713-290-3000 to find the next scheduled event.
