

Northpointe East Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations, for the safe and sanitary operation of the pool, are for your protection and benefit. Rules are subject to change

- Pool Tags are required for entry into the facility.
- No glass containers in the pool/park area.
- All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility.
- Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- Children under 10 years of age, or those that have not passed the swim test, must be accompanied at all times by an individual 17 years of age or older to be admitted to the pool area.
- All members and their guests must register with the lifeguard upon entering the pool facility. Swim tags must be visible at all times.
- Members will be held responsible for the actions of their guests.
- Management will not be held responsible for loss or damage of personal property of any kind.
- The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, overcrowding, and at the discretion of the manager. In case of lightning or thunder, Red Cross current standards will be used.
- Pets are prohibited in the pool area, with the exception of service animals.
- Alcohol and other drugs are prohibited.
- Profanity, improper behavior, and intoxication are not allowed.
- It is requested that any individuals infected with a communicable disease please not enter the pool facility for at least two weeks.
- All non-toilet-trained babies must wear swim diapers.
- The wading pool is limited to children under the age of 6 years old. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.
- Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, dunking, splashing, or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area will not be tolerated.
- No diving in areas 6 feet deep or less per Texas Code.
- Only Coast Guard approved life preservers are permitted and the supervising adult must be within arms reach of the child wearing the life preserver.
- Appropriate swimwear must be worn in the pool. No cut off jeans or pants, shorts or tennis pants, and only white shirts can be worn as protection from the sun in the water.
- Smoking is prohibited inside pool area.
- Persons under the age of 18 are required to leave the pool upon signal of the lifeguard for adult swim. During this period, persons under the age of 18 must be completely out of the water.
- For the safety and enjoyment of all, the lifeguards have full authority to ask disruptive or unruly guests to leave the facility.

Northpointe East Slide Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations, for the safe use of the slide by patrons at the pool, are for your protection and benefit. Rules are subject to change

- LIFEGUARDS HAVE THE ULTIMATE AUTHORITY
- The pool slide will be open for the first 30 minutes of each hour only
- One person at a time on the stairs and/or slide
- Toddlers and non-swimmers are not permitted on the slide
- NO running, standing, kneeling, tumbling or stopping on flumes or in the tunnel
- NO running on the stairs
- Slide in a sitting position or laying on the back feet first only
- NO head first sliding at any time
- One rider at a time. The landing area must be clear before entering the slide
- Leave plunge area immediately after exiting from the slide
- The following types of conduct are prohibited:
 - Horseplay
 - Running on Staircase
 - Diving or flipping while exiting the slide
 - Possession of any toy
 - Use of clothing on the slide – other than swimwear
 - Wearing any comb, bracelet, watch or other jewelry

MAXIMUM CAPACITY OF THE POOL SLIDE IS 300 LBS.
